K4C evenings begin at 4:40 and include:

- 1. Meal Time-** Dinner is shared around tables served by volunteers from the church. Additional volunteers from the church serve as table parents, encouraging healthy relationships while the children are nourished, body and spirit through shared meal time.
- 2. Music-** The goal of the music is to help children learn of God's love in a way that sticks in their hearts and minds with rhythm and fun.
- 3. Homework-** Homework time is devoted to helping children complete assignments (as much as possible) and build relationships with adults who assist them.
- 4. Lesson-** A fun environment to learn is the heart of Kids for Christ. The goal is to nurture the children through biblical lessons that enable the children to know God and live a Christian life.
- 5. Crafts-** Crafts allows children to develop creativity. They form relationships as they create something beautifully unique as they are.
